Snaring the Sun

The Exploits of Maui told by Rev. A. O. Forbes

Once upon a time, in a beautiful place called Makalia, high up on West Maui, there lived a Demi-God named Maui. Maui's Mother was called Hina. Hina had

a special job—she made beautiful kapa cloths, which she spread out to dry under the sun. But the days were so short that by the time she got the kapa spread out, the sun would quickly set, and she'd have to bring them in again. Maui felt very sorry for her and decided he wanted to help.



Maui thought, "If only the Sun would move more slowly, Mom wouldn't have to work so hard." So, he came up with a clever plan to make the Sun go slower. He first traveled to the other side of the island, to watch how the Sun moved. From there, he saw that the Sun rose in the direction of Hana and then moved across the sky. Next, Maui climbed up Haleakala, the great mountain that the Sun passed over and watched its path carefully. After he returned home, Maui set out on a new adventure to gather materials for his plan.

He went to a place called Paeloko, where he cut down lots of tall coconut trees and collected their strong fibers. He twisted the fibers into thick, sturdy cords. While he was working, a person named Moemoe saw him and laughed, saying, "You'll never catch the Sun! You're just wasting your time!"

Maui didn't let this discourage him. He confidently replied, "When I've finished my task and succeeded, you will see." With his strong cords in hand, Maui climbed up Haleakala once more. As the Sun started to rise, Maui prepared his cord and threw it up, catching one of the Sun's big, bright beams. One by one, he snared the Sun's powerful rays and broke them off, making the Sun slower and slower.

"Now, you are my captive!" Maui called out. "You have been moving too quickly, and now you must slow down!"

The Sun, feeling the weight of Maui's cords, begged, "Please let me live. I will promise to move more slowly if you let me go. You have broken my strong rays and left me only with the weak ones."

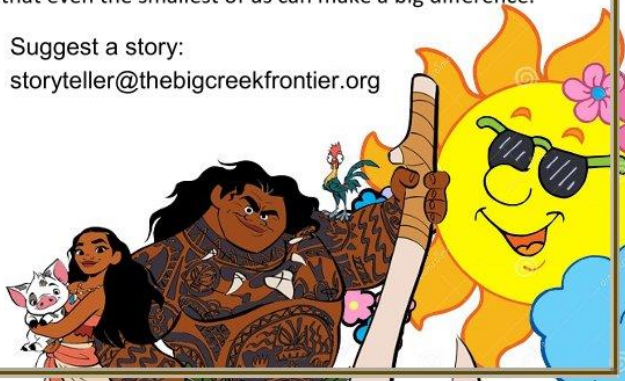
Maui agreed to the Sun's plea. From that day forward, the Sun moved more slowly across the sky, and the days became longer. That's why, sometimes, the days are longer during certain times of the year. The mountain was even named Alehe-ka-la, which means "Sun Snarer," instead of Haleakala.

Maui's bravery and cleverness not only helped his mother but also taught everyone a valuable lesson about perseverance and the power of a well-thought-out plan. He also caught up with Moemoe and taught him a lesson, but that is another story.

And that's how Maui made the days longer and proved that even the smallest of us can make a big difference.
